

## **GWB Ladies' Midweek Pennants – Conditions of Play**

- Each participating club to field a team of 5 players per match.
- Matches are to be played on the day determined by the GWB Committee after circulation of a preliminary draft to all participating clubs for approval and a course availability check. If a Pennant day has to be cancelled because of extreme weather conditions, it will be rescheduled at the earliest opportunity.
- On arrival at the host club, team captains to submit their player lists which show the player's names and their current GA handicap in handicap order.
- Green fees are to be paid at the Pro Shop. Players are responsible for their own lunch orders.
- Host club representatives will determine playing handicaps and issue a card to each player showing their handicap and the name and handicap of their opponent.
- Captains to toss a coin to determine which team has the initial honour.
- Matches to be played in match play format, with the highest markers from each team teeing off first, then continuing in order to the lowest markers.
- Full handicap difference is used to determine the number of strokes given.
- Matches do not go beyond the 18<sup>th</sup> hole.
- Players to notify the host representative of the result of their match.

### **Points**

- A team will score 1 point for each individual match win.
- If a match finishes square at the 18<sup>th</sup> hole, each team scores ½ a point.
- 2 points will be allotted to the winning team in each match.
- If the matches are tied, then 1 point goes to each team.
- Result sheets to be signed by both Team Captains, and forwarded to GWB.

### **Forfeits**

- A Club forfeiting one or more matches must notify the Opposition and the Host Club by 6am on the day of play. The opposing team then only has to field the corresponding number of players needed.
- If a Club cannot field a team of at least 3 players, they must forfeit all matches.

### **Tied Competition**

In the event of a tie at the completion of the year's Pennant competition, the tied clubs will play off at a neutral course, with each match played to conclusion. Venue to be decided by GWB Committee.
